### Safeguarding and Data

We had 12 safeguarding incidents with young people as well as attending 1 Child in Need Meeting, 1 CAMHS meeting, 1 Youth Trust Initial Assessment meeting and an initial Police meeting following a disclosure of historic sexual touching.
